

Florida Private Whistleblower Statute – First Element.

The first element that each plaintiff must prove is that he or she:

(a) threatened to disclose to the Federal Communications Commission, under oath, in writing, an activity, policy, or practice of WTVT in connection with the editing of the plaintiffs' proposed news report on artificial bovine growth hormone (BGH), and the plaintiff, in writing, brought the activity, policy, or practice of WTVT to the attention of a supervisor or the employer and afforded the employer a reasonable opportunity to correct the activity, policy, or practice; and, or in the alternative,

(b) objected to, or refused to participate in, WTVT's activity, policy, or practice in connection with the editing of the plaintiffs' proposed news report on artificial BGH.
